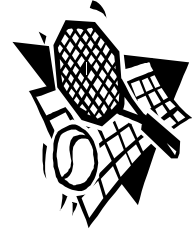

Annual General Meeting

All members are hereby informed of the 2000 Annual General Meeting of St. Peter's Parish Tennis Club, to be on **Monday August 14th at 7:30 p.m.** in the Parish Centre. All members should attend so they can have a say in the future of their Club.

Furthermore, at the AGM the Committee will be inviting members to comment on a proposed increase in fees for the 2000/2001 membership year. In order to cover increasing maintenance costs and planned works on Courts 3 and 4, the Committee has proposed a \$5-\$10 increase in membership fees. Nonetheless, the fees will still remain by far the lowest in the local area. The proposed changes are as follows:

Category	Previous Fee	New Fee
Family	\$45	\$55
Senior	\$30	\$40
Student	\$22.50	\$30
Junior	\$15	\$20

Please note: The proposed fee changes are not in any way related to the GST. As a sub-entity of the Parish, SPPTC is not required to collect GST.

Junior Report



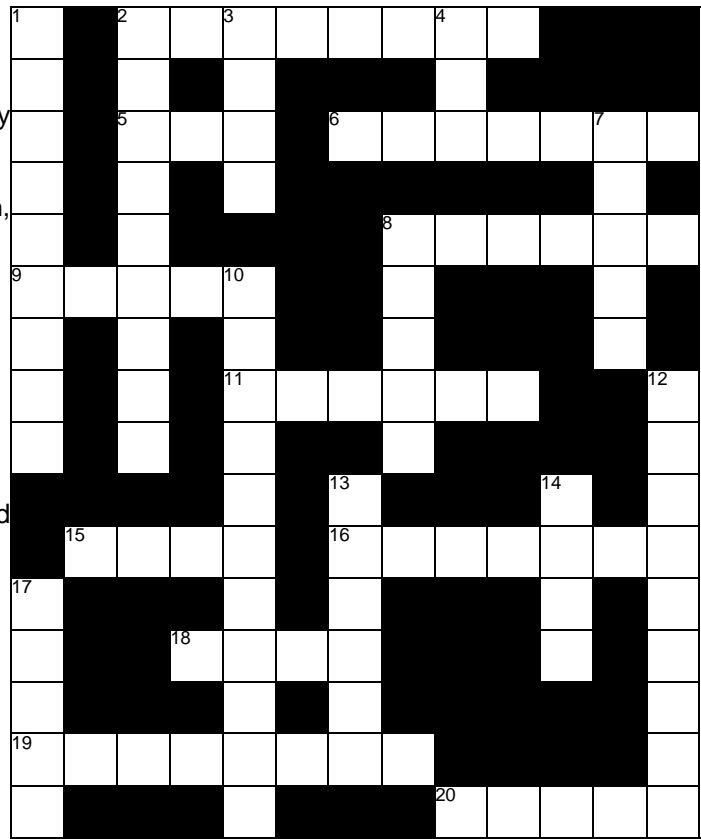
