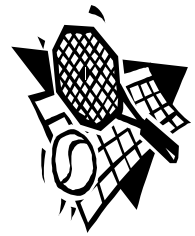

Annual General Meeting

The 2001 Annual General Meeting of St. Peter's Parish Tennis Club will be held on **Monday August 13th** at **7:30 p.m.** in the Parish Centre. All members are encouraged to attend so they can have a say in the future of their Club.

Last year the Club was forced to reschedule the Annual General meeting as a quorum was not reached. It is hoped that this will not be the case this year and as many members as possible will turn up. All it takes is an hour of your time to help your Club run smoothly.

All members are also encouraged to consider joining the Committee. The Committee meets once a month on the final Tuesday of the month and is responsible for the general running of the Club and organisation of competition teams. The final stage of the resurfacing of Courts 3 and 4 will take place during the September school holidays. The plexipave surface will be relayed starting on **September 24th**. It is anticipated that it will take two weeks and the courts will be available again by the end of the school holidays. During this time Courts 1 and 2 can be used as usual.


The relaying of the plexipave surface has been delayed until the September school holidays due to unsuitable weather during July and August. Members are thanked for their co-operation in using the bitumen courts during this period.

St. Peter's just keeps getting better

St. Peter's Parish Tennis Club has recently undertaken a number of new initiatives to improve the facilities available to members and players in competition teams. Some of the improvements include:

1. A drinks vending fridge has been purchased for the Parish Centre so that players from St. Peter's and opposition teams can buy cans of drink while at the Club. This service is particularly provided for night team players, who do not have access to a canteen (unlike juniors).
2. Table tennis bats, balls and a net have been purchased and are kept in the ladies' toilets along with the table tennis table (which many members may not know about). Competition players are welcome to play table tennis while waiting between sets, or if it is raining.
3. An ice pack, which can also act a heat pack, has been purchased and is kept in the freezer in the kitchen and can be used to treat any injuries that may occur.
4. New nets have been placed on Courts 1 and 2. Hopefully this will stop the arguments over whether the ball went over the net or through it!

In the near future, the Club also plans to buy a television for the Parish Centre for players to watch while they are waiting between sets. Along with the resurfacing of Courts 3 and 4, it is clear that St. Peter's is just getting better and better. Anyone with suggestions on how to further improve the Club should come along to the Annual General Meeting and put their ideas forward!
