Rubbish and Recycling

Night tennis teams are reminded that there are recycling bins with yellow lids at the rear of the Parish Centre (outside the back door to the kitchen) for the disposal of recyclable materials. All glass and plastic bottles should be placed in these recycle bins, not the rubbish bins. Please ensure all **bottles are emptied into the sink** before placing them in the bin.

If the rubbish bins in the Parish Centre are full at the end of the night, the bins should be emptied and the rubbish put in the bins at the rear of the Parish Centre with red lids. New bin liners can be found in the bottom drawer under the sink.

Club Championships 2010

The 2010 Club Championships were played throughout February and March. Thirty five players took part in the junior events and fifteen players took part in the senior events, which was a strong turn out.

The senior events were originally planned to be completed over the first two Saturdays, but due to heavy rain on the second Saturday when finals were due to be played, some doubles matches were pushed back. Fortunately, these matches were able to be rescheduled and were completed on a following Saturday.

This year the junior events were scheduled over three Saturdays instead of two, with the A and C Grade events played on a different day to the B and D Grade events, in order to avoid the delays experienced the year before. This system seemed to work much better, although some B Grade events (which had the largest number of entrants) still had to be completed on Monday afternoon due to the number of matches being played. Thanks go to all the parents that assisted running the events, in particular Cheryl Tenace, Joanna Carasavidis, Claudia Mantello and Peter Parisi. Thanks also go to all the players for their patience during delays due to long matches and courts being full.

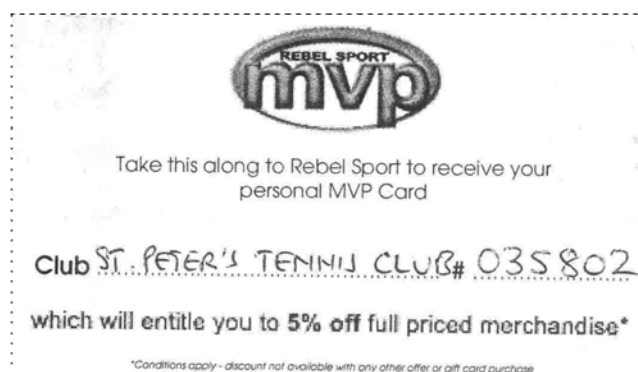

Oscar winner Russell Crowe stars as the legendary figure known by generations as Robin Hood, whose exploits have endured in popular mythology and ignited the imagination of those who share his spirit of adventure and righteousness. In 13th century England, Robin and his band of marauders confront corruption in a local village and lead an uprising against the crown that will forever alter the balance of world power. And whether thief or hero, one man from humble beginnings will become an eternal symbol of freedom for his people.

Robin Hood chronicles the life of an expert archer, previously interested only in self-preservation, from his service in King Richards army against the French. Upon Richards death, Robin travels to Nottingham, a town suffering from the corruption of a despotic sheriff and crippling taxation, where he falls for the spirited widow Lady Marian (Oscar winner Cate Blanchett), a woman skeptical of the identity and motivations of this crusader from the forest. Hoping to earn the hand of Maid Marian and salvage the village, Robin assembles a gang whose lethal mercenary skills are matched only by its appetite for life. Together, they begin preying on the indulgent upper class to correct injustices under the sheriff.

With their country weakened from decades of war, embattled from the ineffective rule of the new king and vulnerable to insurgencies from within and threats from afar, Robin and his men heed a call to ever greater adventure. This unlikeliest of heroes and his allies set off to protect their country from slipping into bloody civil war and return glory to England once more.

The cost of the season is \$45. Fees must be sent with this form.

All players are reminded of the following conditions of entry:

1. All players must be **current financial members** of St. Peter's Parish Tennis Club. Non-members must contact Michelle Murrell on 9337 2346 to arrange to become members.
2. **All teams are selected by the Senior Selection Committee** on the basis of ability. A player who submits an entry must play in the team the Selection Committee places them in.
3. If a group of players enter expecting to be put in a team together, every effort will be made to comply with this request. However, the final team is subject to alteration by the Selection Committee based on the needs of the Club. For example, if a new player wishes to join, they will be placed in a team of their standard where the most suitable vacancy exists. This applies across the board to the Mixed, Ladies' and Men's competitions.
4. All players must act as captain when selected. Refusal to do so may result in the player being withdrawn from the team.
5. Once a form has been submitted, a commitment has been made and withdrawal causes inconvenience to all concerned. Players who withdraw after entries are submitted and do not provide the Committee with a satisfactory reason are ineligible to play in St. Peter's teams for a period of 12 months (two seasons).
